ADULT PSYCHIATRIC BEDS IN INLAND EMPIRE

- Inland Empire has an acute psychiatric bed shortfall of 377 beds, or 10.9 beds per 100,000 adults.
- Inland Empire has a subacute psychiatric bed shortfall of 372 beds, or 10.7 beds per 100,000 adults.
- Inland Empire has a residential psychiatric bed shortfall of 567 beds, or 16.4 beds per 100,000 adults.

**Note: State hospital beds were not included in calculations of psychiatric bed capacity. Over 90% of state hospital beds are occupied by individuals who are incompetent to stand trial, a population with unique constraints that does not apply to the local behavioral health continuum. Exclusion of state hospitals has the secondary benefit of modeling need for psychiatric beds if state hospitals were transitioned to local, community-based alternatives.*
